**Joyce O'Connell** is an International Award Winning Quilt Artist who has a broad knowledge of both traditional and innovative quilting designs and techniques. She has been juried into many competitions and shows, and her work has been exhibited in Canada, the United States and England. She had a solo exhibition of her work "Bargello Inspirations" at the Waterloo Quilt Gallery in St. Jacobs, Ontario, where she exhibited many of her original Bargello designs.

For our meeting, Joyce will speak about **"The Story of the Underground Railroad Quilt Code".** Using a full size Underground Railroad sampler quilt, she will explain the quilt codes and how they were used along the route to freedom.
