# 2021/2022 Past President Challenge - What's In My Name? For May 11, 2022

(Updated March 27, 2022)

#### The Challenge:

- Use your 3 initials to suggest <u>colours</u>, <u>blocks</u> and/or <u>images</u> to create a small quilted item.
- · If you don't have a middle name, use one of your other initials twice
- You must include 3 prompts ie 1 colour, 1 block name, and 1 image; or 2 colours and one block name, or 2 images and one colour...on the front of your project (backing or lining do not count)
- Your entry must be the equivalent of a finished, completed item a top layer, a batting/lining, and a backing; quilted or tied; finished as appropriate. Appliqué is acceptable and will count as an image.
- Up to a total size of 84", adding up all sides.
- Consider making something that you might like to donate to Community Outreach or fund raising....lots of possibilities zip bags or totes, Ipad/Kobo cases, table topper, placemat, wall hanging, etc).
- Hopefully we'll be viewing these in person, but if still virtual, the small projects will be easy to photograph

### For Example, if your name is Cindy Lou Who, Quilter

• Cat's Cradle blocks (block), Lavender (colour) and White (colour), made into a placemat

#### 2021/2022 Past President Challenge - What's In My Name? For May 11, 2022 (Updated March 27, 2022)

- Printed <u>C</u>at fabric (image) on a <u>L</u>ime background (colour) made into <u>W</u>indmill blocks (block), joined together for a placemat
- Celery green background (colour) combined with printed Ladybug fabric (image), made using the Whirlygig block pattern could be a doll quilt or a tote bag
- A Churn Dash (block) could be made with fruit printed fabrics Lemons (colour or images) and Limes (colour or images) and Watermelons (images) - and finished as table topper
- Where to get ideas? Colour names from fabric lines, paint chips, kid's crayons. Get block names from the internet, quilt books, magazines

Example #2: for Cindy Lou Who, Quilter



- C Checkerboard (Block)
- L Lemon Yellow (Colour)
- W Words (Image) or White (Colour)

This is a small doll quilt (approximately 18 x 22 that will be donated.
